	<p>Learning Conditions Audit</p> <p>Undertake a process of building a clear picture of the conditions under which learners and teachers will be working from home.</p> <p>This may involve surveys, interviews, phone calls etc, as well as drawing from existing data that the school/kura/centre holds.</p> <p>Needs to take account of both the context of learners as well as the context of teachers as some of them will likely need to work from home during periods of isolation.</p>
