Enable students to personalise learning

Set up the learning space so students can adjust it.

Make options and supports available to everyone.

- Create opportunities where students can personalise learning tasks and projects and build on their knowledge, experience, and strengths.
- ✓ Develop success criteria with the students and present them with clear visual supports.
- ✓ Provide opportunities for students to gain confidence using a range of media so they can select the most appropriate.
- ✓ Make support tools (text-to-speech, graphic organisers, planning tools, and so on) available for all students.
- ✓ Offer a flexible learning environment with a variety of seating and working spaces.
