The Expanded Core Curriculum helps learners with low vision to access and participate in the regular curriculum, and achieve positive learning outcomes. It is complementary to *Te Whāriki* and *The New Zealand Curriculum* and does not replace them.

The Expanded Core Curriculum has been adopted internationally. It is incorporated in the **BLENNZ Curriculum** (2017).
