Using the Spiral of Inquiry framework helped Woodend School plan for using digital technologies to support learning and teaching in an ILE.

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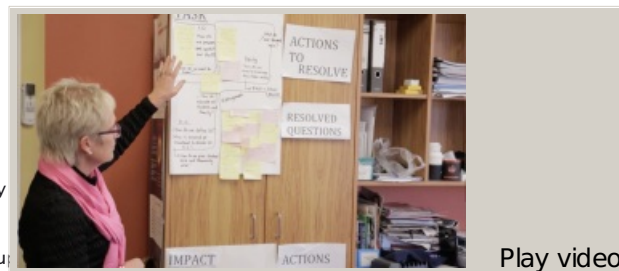
