Develop collaborative teaching practices

For many teachers moving from single cell classrooms into a collaborative teaching space requires a significant shift in pedagogy and ways of working. Provide training and coaching to support high levels of communication, relational skills, and trust.

- ✓ Start by having pairs of teachers plan together.
- ✓ Support them in higher-level thinking, not compliance.
- ✓ Help them to review their process and identify what's effective
 both in their classroom practice and in their relationships during this development.
