## Design respectful forms and surveys

When asking students, family, or whānau to fill out forms or surveys at school, consider whether you really need to collect data about their gender.

If you do, either:

- ▲ leave a blank space for students to write in their own gender identity, or
- ▲ include an “Other” option box alongside the male and female boxes.
