Embed inclusive language

Even small gestures can feel enormous to an individual student.

Consider ways to increase the use of gender-diverse language in your classroom.

Consider presenting:

- ▲ a short story with same-sex parents in the family
- ▲ a maths problem where Dan and his boyfriend, Jai, order a pizza
- ▲ scenarios with gender-neutral language
- ▲ visuals and images that represent diverse sexual identities
- ▲ LGBTIQ+ role models, such as artists, writers, and historical figures in class topics.

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
