Offer physical and digital tools

Support access to a variety of tools and approaches giving students options in how they present and share their learning.

Visual tools and approaches:

drawings, graphics, infographics, posters, acrostics, comics
mural, display, timeline, collage, installation
board game, magazine, brochure, digital presentation
movie, storyboard, stop motion film, photographs, advert.

Auditory tools and approaches:

write and record songs, raps, slam poetry, jingles
voice avatar (Voki or Voicethread)
make a news report, podcast
conversation in social media (Twitter or Facebook)
publish a blog post, website
design a survey and interview, talk show, debate, lecture,
questions for a trivia show
soundtrack to a novel, poem, time period, feeling.

Physical tools and approaches:

construct a model (for example, diorama), installation,
sculpture
create a role play, skit, tableau, dance, puppet show,
demonstration, costumes.

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
